5. What does it mean to "humble" yourself before God?
6. In vv. 7-10 James tells us to "Submit therefore to God" and then lists out what this looks like (resist the devil, draw near to God, etc). Which of those seems especially important for your life right now?
7. Why is it important for us to acknowledge that we have to personally choose to pursue these things?
8. In v. 8 James says, "Draw near to God and He will draw near to you."  
Have you experienced this before? Talk it through.
